RIVER RALLY EVENTS

The Downstream River Rally

Our most popular river rally combines the enjoyment of our Scenic River Rafting Tour with the most team-oriented and fun rally games and events. Our standard length float is provided, along with our most popular teambuilding activities: Slalom Gates, the Sprint and the Tarzan Swing.

Slalom Gates is an event that requires groups of guests to work together, negotiating their rafts through a series of downstream and upstream river gates. The maneuvers become more difficult as the course proceeds. The Sprint is essentially a good old-fashioned race to the finish, requiring that guests work together to beat the competition to the checkered flag. The tour ends with what has emerged as our most popular, fun, and often hilarious shore game, the Tarzan Swing. In the Tarzan Swing, guests swing across an imaginary chasm to an “island.” As the “island” fills, more and more creativity is required by the guests to accommodate their incoming teammates on the tiny “island.”

The primary advantage of our Downstream River Rally is that all of the events included can only be won by a team effort (instead of by the outstanding effort of one team member) and that everyone on the tour still has the opportunity to enjoy a full length river float.

Please allow 4 – 5 hours round-trip from the resort for our Downstream River Rally.

The Frog Pond River Rally

For groups that want a greater emphasis on river games than on floating downstream, or groups that simply have less time to spend at the river, our Frog Pond River Rally may be a perfect fit! The games from our Downstream River Rally (Slalom Gates, the Sprint and the Tarzan Swing) are combined with other events such as the No Paddle Race, the Three-Legged Race, the Throw Bag Toss, Raft Right, the Round Up, the Ducky Relay, Hunker Hawser and Bun Darts in a program customized to suit your requirements.

The No Paddle Race and Three-Legged Race are essentially more challenging variations of the Sprint. The Throw bag toss and Raft Right simulate actual river rescue techniques and are appropriate for small groups of guests who don't mind getting wet. The Round Up is an event designed for large groups (100 or more) wherein teams of 4 or more boats attempt to form a circle, capturing an opposing team's boat inside. The Ducky Relay/Raft Relay is another race, this one designed around shuttling your teammates back and forth across the river. Finally Hunker Hawser and Bun Darts are both popular shore games.

The Frog Pond River Rally may not include traveling downstream on the river *at all*. In some cases, however, a short float downstream can be included.

Please allow 3 ½ - 4 ½ hours round-trip from the resort for our Frog Pond River Rally.
